## In the Footsteps of the Pharaohs

Tony Minieri will be teaching for the Austin Stitchery Guild on November 12-15, 2010. This year he's teaching In the Footsteps of the Pharaohs, a companion piece to Patterns of the Orient and Journey to Satchidanada.

Pharaohs is the third in Tony's series of beautiful textile collages based on ancient fabric designs. But even though it's the third in the series it can also stand alone. It uses Needlepoint Inc. Silk, Kreinik braids, Coronet Braid, J. Walsh Silk & Wool, beads and Gold Bullion in coral, indigo, laurel green and turquoise with gold metallics and metals. Pharaohs includes flat patterns, Jessica's, crescents, Fern, Bokhara couching, diagonal pattern couching, eyelets, offsetting patterns and tied sheaves to name some of the stitches and techniques.



Class will be held at the Clarion Inn on I35 again this year. The deposit is \$235, which will cover your kit fee and we will divide the balance of Tony's expenses among those in the class.
